John Rajani is Head of the Representation of the Faroe Islands to Israel.

Before arriving in Israel, John Rajani has had an active professional career for more than twenty-five years. Prior to taking the position as Representative of the Faroe Islands, John Rajani was Managing Partner and owner of a corporate finance advisory firm (2015-2020).

Earlier John Rajani worked for ten years (2006-2015) in the financial sector on a strategic management level as Head of Corporate Finance, Head of Corporate Banking and Managing Director/Deputy CEO in a listed Bank. During this time John Rajani has worked with large organizational, operational, regulatory and technological transformations as the bank during this period expanded from the Faroese marketplace to also being present in Denmark, Iceland and Greenland.

John Rajani also worked for ten years in the public sector, primarily as Principal Private Secretary to the Prime Minister in the Faroe Islands (1998-2002) and with foreign affairs as the Representative of the Faroe Islands in the UK (2002-2005). From 2005-2006 John Rajani was Director of Economic Development and Strategy at the Prime Minister's Office.

John Rajani started his career in the seafood industry, and this has since that time been one of his great interests.

John Rajani holds a B.Sc. Degree in Economics and Business Administration from Copenhagen Business School, Denmark, and a Master of Business Administration (MBA) from the University of Lancaster, United Kingdom.
